# Poster Design Contest hopes to reflect love of area park

When Lawrence Sahulka was first transferred here two years ago, his family remained in Texas until his daughter finished high school. He used that first year alone to explore the area.

"I would travel out to the surrounding neighborhoods of Cincinnati and Northern Kentucky, trying to figure out where best to take up residence," says Sahulka, who was born and raised in Winnipeg, Manitoba, Canada.

Anderson Township quickly went to the top of the

list. "It became my favorite part of the metro, mainly because of the green space, parks facilities, local school system, safe neighborhoods and the friendliness of the residents," he says.

That fondness for his adopted community is reflected in his winning poster design.

"I was motivated to enter the contest because I'm an Anderson Township resident and I have a great appreciation for the park system here," he says.

His approach was to "visually celebrate the week-end event in an expressive, sophisticated manner that

was fitting for the 10th anniversary milestone," he says.

Architectural landscape design references seen at Beech Acres Park were incorporated to note the event's location, while depiction of the Sunday fireworks display helped emphasize the "crescendo moment" of the festivities, he says.

Sahulka has studied and worked in the field of graphic design for the last 18 years, but has been artistically inclined since he was a child.

"My parents would enroll me in art classes at the downtown YMCA back when I was 5 year old," he says. "I guess I knew back then that I

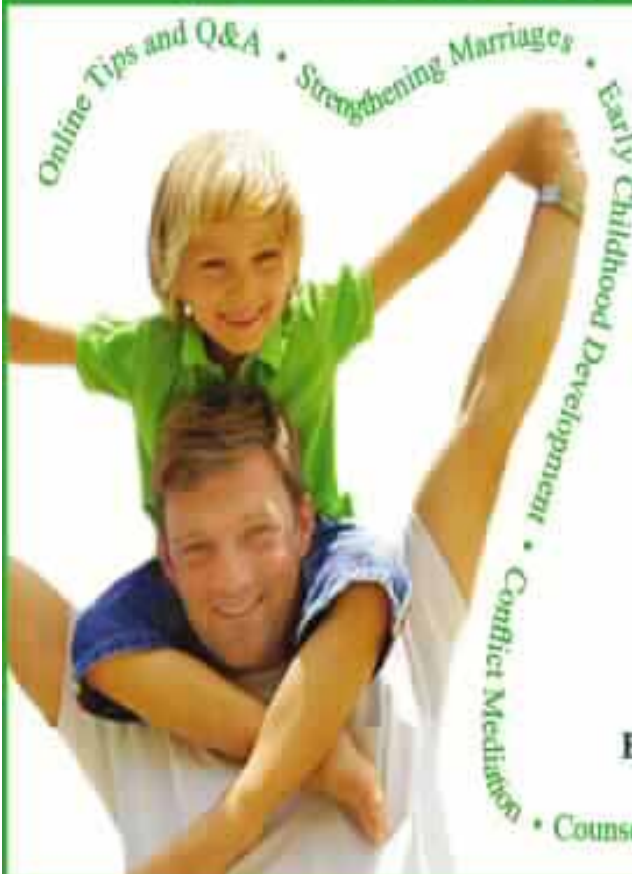


was good at art for my age, and that I also enjoyed myself when I was doing it."
