

**Commissioners' Message**

**PARTNERSHIPS HELP PROVIDE NEEDED UPGRADES TO BUSY CLEAR CREEK PARK**

A drive down Ohio 32 alongside Clear Creek Park on a sunny autumn morning reveals what many parents already know firsthand - Clear Creek Park is a hotbed of activity from dawn to dusk during the fall sports season.

This 131-acre park, open since 1996, is the site of 24 active soccer/lacrosse/ultimate frisbee fields that stay full many weekends out of the year. Park staff members estimate that during the busy season, some 8,000-10,000 people may visit the park in just two days.

With such a flurry of activity moving teams in and out of the area every few hours, parking

can be an issue. The current configuration of parking space at Clear Creek includes some 269 spots, with overflow parking designated to grassy areas. This is not an ideal situation during a rainy spring or fall. Surveys undertaken by the Anderson Township Park District over the years note that residents consider this park's parking options less than optimum and have requested upgrades.

The good news for Clear Creek Park users is a better parking situation will be in place. The parks have found partners to help to provide 110 more paved parking spots for Clear Creek patrons. As an added bonus, the permeable

pavers being installed at Clear Creek will help eliminate surface water pollutants and reduce surface runoff water into the Little Miami and Ohio rivers. A grant from the Ohio Epa 319 NonPoint Source Program has funded the lion's share of the parking lot improvements.

Clear Creek has historically benefited from other partnerships. The park district partnered with a youth group that helped install brick paver pathways and an arbor structure in 1996. The award-winning "Oasis" project features an arbor area encrusted with foliage of wisteria vines providing naturally filtered shade.



**PERMEABLE PAVER BENEFITS**

- Reduces polluted runoff from rain water up to 100 percent, which in turn reduces downstream flooding and stream bank erosion.
- Minimizes existing storm sewer systems issues.
- Maximizes the process of water moving to the water table.
- Helps reduce urban heat buildup and heat buildup on surface waters.
- Reduces winter ice hazards as snow melts faster on permeable pavement.
- Decreases costs by reducing drainage and retention/detention systems.
- Reduces cost of meeting storm water regulatory requirements.
- Allows better land-use planning and more efficient use of available land for greater economic value.


Community joins together in Celebration to Remember to honor loved ones on September 6






