## Metal Detector Permit Registration

Permit may be secured at Juiff's Park Office, 8249 Clough Pike, Cincinnati, OH. **No fee.** You must complete form, have your photo ID taken, and the permit is to be worn when using your metal detector on Anderson Township Park property. It must be shown to any park personnel, if asked.

Use of a metal detector is not permitted on **Park District soccer fields, William McNeilan Johnson Hills Park, areas designated for horticulture use, the in-field area of all ball fields, or areas closed to the public.** Tool used for probing must be similar to a screwdriver, with a blade length of no more than six (6) inches, width of no more than 1/2 inch. Each area disturbed must be returned to a natural state. **Metal Detectors may be used only on weekdays during daylight hours.**

Section 1 of the Anderson Township Park District By-Laws reads as follows: "No person shall injure, deface, disturb or defoul any part of the Park, nor any building, sign, equipment, nor other property found therein; Nor shall any tree, flower, shrub, rock or mineral be removed, injured or destroyed."

Violation of any of the above will result in the revocation of User's permit. Penalty for violations of Section 1 of the Anderson Township Park District By-Laws is a minor misdemeanor crime and could result in a court citation and fine.

### **Release of Liability and Authorization**

I, the undersigned, knowingly and freely accept all risks associated with my use of the Anderson Township Park District's property. I hereby release the Anderson Township Park District (ATPD), the Anderson Foundation for Parks and Recreation, and Anderson Township Government – and their respective Boards, employees, agents, instructors, coaches, volunteers, assignees, and sponsors from any and all loss, claim, judgment, damage, and/or liability arising out of any incident, injury, or accident sustained while using the Park District's property.
