Anderson field to belong to Brennaman

ANDERSON TWP. - Marty Brennaman Field will debut in the spring of 2008, hosting Little League baseball games in Anderson Township.

The ballpark to honor the legendary Cincinnati Reds broadcaster and longtime Anderson Township resident will be located at Juilfs Park.

The announcement of Marty Brennaman Field was made at the conclusion of the Cincinnati Bell Technology Solutions Marty Brennaman Golf Classic held at Belterra Casino Resort & Spa on Sept. 9 and 10.

The idea and planning for the redesigned field started taking shape a year and half ago, said Reds Community Fund executive director Charlie Frank.

"We are always looking for ways to connect our fundraising efforts with our community outreach program," said Frank. "Building new fields is not really our style, but we figured this was a great way to thank Marty for his support of the Reds Community Fund and also establish a permanent connection in Anderson Township."

The field will include a press box, bleachers, and new dugouts.

The planning was secretive, as all parties involved wanted to surprise Brennaman with the honor. Now that the word is out, the community is buzzing with excitement.

"I see this as a win-win-win for the Reds Community Fund, the Anderson Park District, and the Anderson

Township Little League. As the ATLL enters our 10th year next spring, we were searching for a way to honor one of our biggest backers, Marty Brennaman. This generous contribution from the Reds Community Fund in partnership with the Anderson Park District will achieve that goal," ATLL vice president J. Jay Lewis said.

"The real winners will be the kids that will be able to play games on Marty Brennaman Field next spring and for years to come."
