Now in its 10th year, Greater Anderson Days features food from local area restaurants, live entertainment, Rozzi's Famous Fireworks, a fun and informative Business Expo, an assortment of games, rides, the 64th Annual Fireman's Festival.

Proceeds benefit the Anderson Township Park District Playground Fund and the Anderson Township Fireman's Association.

This year there is a Greater Anderson Days 10th Anniversary poster design contest. The poster design should emphasize the Greater Anderson Days' 10th Anniversary, and reflect the spirit and essence of this Anderson community celebration.

The benefits to the selected winner are:

* Your design will become the face of Greater Anderson Days; it will be on the cover of 85,000 event mini-books that are inserted in various Community Press newspapers. As the winner, you will also receive recognition in the event mini-book.

- * 500 posters and 4,000 fliers of your design will be distributed and displayed throughout eastern Cincinnati, including Anderson area businesses.

- * Recognition on the Greater Anderson Days official Web site, www.AndersonParks.com/ADays.

- * You will receive recognition as the contest winner during the event from the main stage.

- * An event goodie bag that contains: three Greater Anderson Days posters and T-shirts, one VIP parking pass to event for the entire three-day weekend and two VIP tickets for you to attend the sponsor reception on Sunday night.

The contest guidelines are:

- * Contest is open to ages 18 and older.

- * Art work files are to be vector based only (Adobe Illustrator) and submitted in CMYK. Photography or photographic images of any kind will not be accepted.

- * Vibrant colors are highly encouraged.

- * Art work must be designed for a vertical format of 18-by-24 inches, but may be scaled down (no smaller than 8.5 x 11 page) for entry submission.

- * The winning design and design rights become the property of the Greater Anderson Days Event Coordinator - Anderson Township Park District - and must be easily adaptable for T-shirts, print ads and fliers.

- * Designs must be original art work created by the submitting artist and may not incorporate any copyrighted materials.

- * Entries will be evaluated based on appeal, creativity, and marketability. The review committee at the Anderson Township Park District will select the winning design.

- * There is no limit to the number of entries submitted.

- * The design must incorporate the following: Greater Anderson Days; 10th Annual Community Celebration; July 25-27, 2008; Beech Acres Park, 6910 Salem Road; Benefiting the ATPD Playground Fund & The Fireman's Association; Event Logo (e-mail ACottrill@AndersonParks.com for artwork); Times: Friday 5 p.m.-11 p.m., Saturday 5 p.m.-11 p.m., Sunday 5 p.m.-10 p.m.; Fireworks Sunday at 10 p.m.; Free Shuttle from McNicholas High School; Limited parking on Salem Road; 2.5" h x 17" w place holder for sponsor logos; www.AndersonParks.com/Adays.

The submission deadline is Friday, May 16. The winner will be notified by Friday, May 23.
