

Anderson Township ready to show off park

ANDERSON TWP. — A \$2 million redevelopment of Beech Acres Park off Salem Road is wrapping up and should be complete by June 10, in time for the first summer concert there.

Over the past several years, the park has received new ball fields, a skate park, soccer fields and a mile-long hike/bike trail; amphitheater and pavilion; and restroom and concession building, said Molly McClure, executive director of the Anderson Park District.

Planning for a children's play area at Beech Acres should be done by summer's end, but it's not

certain when it will be built.

Coming later in June will be the opening of Anderson's dog park in Kellogg Park, McClure said. A temporary dog park has been open since November at Riverside Park.
