

Anderson Park District gets ready for Haunted Hike

The Anderson Park District's Haunted Hike is open from 7:30-10 p.m. Friday, Oct. 22, and Saturday, Oct. 23, at Kellogg Park, 6701 Kellogg Ave. near River Downs Race Track.

The hike is a 15-minute trek on the luminary-lit terror trail that winds through Kellogg Park along the Ohio River.
