



Park district moves forward with synthetic fields

Riverside Park will likely have a synthetic fields by the end of August.

The Anderson Township Park District is moving forward with plans to install synthetic fields at the park on Round Bottom Road.

Executive Director Ken Kushner said the Park District is working on engineering plans for the \$ 1.6 million project, which includes lighting, a parking lot and the field.

Park Commissioner Dale Bartholomew suggested installing sewer lines to the concession stand and the location of future buildings while the field is under construction, to avoid digging twice.

Bartholomew said the Park District would later be able to tap into the Metropolitan Sewer District's planned sewer along Round Bottom Road when that is constructed.

Park Commissioner Nadine Gelter expressed concerns about the additional money and labor to install the lines.

Operations Manager Mike Smith said he would check to see if it was possible to add the sewer lines for the Park District.

Kushner said the engineering plans will include possible locations for future buildings and the layout of the fields, which will be able to accommodate soccer, football and other field

sports.

Construction is expected to start in mid-May.
