Park district responds to cell tower resistance

ANDERSON TWP. - There are still a number of steps to take before construction can begin on the proposed cell tower.

Ken Kushner, executive director of the Anderson Township Park District, said Arcadia Communications still needs to file an application before the Board of Zoning Appeals can decide if the tower meets the criteria to go on the property.

"If either the residents or (Arcadia) are not happy with it, then it can go to the Court of Common Pleas," Kushner said.

The license agreement between the park district and Arcadia Communications created an uproar among residents. Although Kushner is aware of the opposition, he has not seen the petition started by Barry Peterson.

"People are resistant to change, but the property is going to change," Kushner said, adding that there was a lot of resistance when Julifs Park was being developed.

The issue will be discussed further at the Anderson Township Park District meeting at 6:30 p.m., on Thursday, April 10, at the Julifs Park office at 8249 Clough Pike.
