



ANDERSON TOWNSHIP PARK DISTRICT DOG FIELD RULES



AREA UNDER SURVEILLANCE

- All users must purchase the required Dog Field Permit and comply with the following requirements to enter Off-Leash Dog Field.
Annual permit holders:
 - * Dog handler must wear proper Dog Field identification; ID must be visible at all times.
Daily permit holders:
 - * Purchase daily permit and drop fee in lock box.
 - * Using provided safety pin, visibly display temporary permit tag on garment.
 - * If desired, convert daily permit to an annual permit at the Anderson Township Park District office: Juilfs Park, 8249 Clough Pike
- The Off-Leash Dog Field is for dogs, their handlers and those accompanying them.
- Owners are legally responsible for their dog(s) and any injury caused by them. If your dog becomes unruly or aggressive, leash immediately and leave the field. In case of incident, owners are required to provide personal information to involved parties.
- Dogs must be licensed and vaccinated, and wearing a collar with current tags.
- Dogs under the age of four months are not permitted.
- Female dogs in season are not permitted.
- Dog owners must keep their dog(s) in view at all times.
- There is a limit of 3 dogs per owner at any given time.
- Clean up and dispose of feces left by your dog per section 511.23.15b of the Ohio Revised Code.
- Owners must carry a leash at all times. All dogs must be leashed in all other areas of the Anderson Park District.
- Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Please maintain the safety of the transfer gate system. Do not enter if another dog is within the transfer area.
- Food and dog treats are not permitted inside the Dog Field.
- Unattended dogs will be removed by the SPCA.
- Failure to fulfill annual or daily permit requirements and follow Dog Field rules, subjects a violator to criminal prosecution, and/or being banned from the Field.
